## Bridging job gaps amidst global financial meltdown

Business hub CALABARZON is palpitating from the impact of the economic crisis as thousands of workers are displaced. Headlined by the DOLE, with DTI and TESDA, along with the LGUs and other agencies, the government acts with dispatch to contain the impact.

**A** leading industrial center in the country with about 4.7 million labor force, Calabarzon's vulnerability is in the forefront of a potentially detrimental economic meltdown.

Host to 48 economic zones, 17 of them in Laguna, 13 in Cavite, 12 in Batangas, and two in Rizal, the region is the vally hard-hit by the financial downturn sweeping the global economic landscape. Returning overseas workers swell the ranks of the already distressed local workers.

By the beginning of the year, bleak effects of the crisis have resonated among the labor ranks with thousands of jobs and livelihood placed under threat. Figures from the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) in general off as reveals that as of end of June this year, there are 52,750 workers affected in 246 establishments in the region, 23,978 or 46 percent of them were placed under flexible working arrangement. Among the industries, the electronics sector was blown the hardest with 21,883 workers. Far next is the automotive industries affecting 12,465 workers. Other sectors reporting affected workforce are services, manufacturing and garments industries.

The Calabarzon DOLE data further showed that among the impacted workers, 24,334 men and women lost their jobs.

During the same period, DOLE identified 32 establishments reporting a total of 14,567 happy workers to have returned to work as rehires, all of them on temporary basis; 96 among them working on reduced or flexible hours.

Confronted by this lofty challenge, the regional government collectively rose above the threat, seizing opportunities.
